Orthopaedic/Trauma Outpatients

Each consultant has a set morning clinic from 9am - 1pm. *The last appointment is booked at 11:15 to allow time for treatment.* The consultants each have their own day in the clinic.

- Tuesday - Mr Shardlow
- Wednesday - Mr Ncube
- Thursday - Mr Smibert
- Friday pm - Mr Macted

Following your injury, you will either be admitted to the hospital or you will have been treated by a member of the accident & emergency team or the orthopaedic/trauma "on call" team.

You will then be asked to attend the next available fracture/trauma clinic.

You will be under the care of the consultant team who were "on call" on the day of your accident.

Due to limited space in the waiting area, please restrict the number of relatives/carers who accompany you. Children, 16 years or younger, must be accompanied by a responsible adult. Frail or infirm patients, who usually need a carer - those from nursing/ residential homes- will need to be accompanied.

The clinics are very busy and you will need to allow approximately 1-2 hours for each clinic attendance. This is to allow time for your treatment plan to be decided and discussed with you. You may require wound dressings, plaster casts, blood tests, x-rays, etc.

THIS ALL TAKES TIME

We realise that this is a very stressful time for you and any planning you can make in advance of your hospital appointment will help.

Changes to your daily arrangements may be needed, ie, the collection of children from school, organising relatives and pets.

You may wish to inform your school or employer of the expected length of your appointment.

Accidents are not planned and everyone will need to be seen at the next available clinic. We can not know how many patients to expect. This may result in a number of bookings for one time slot.

If you have any exceptional difficulties, please let us know and we will be happy to advise.
